Visit to a Sugar Plant

CSC Sugar is nestled in the Fairless Hills area of eastern Pennsylvania. This is a relatively new industrial park located in a GPS location impossible to find. Just drive around in circles, don't ask the locals because they do not know and eventually see a sign and arrive. CSC makes the connection between buyers and millers and growers to increase the supply of sustainable cane sugar. Raw produce is brought in from mostly Central America, Mexico and the Caribbean area.

Sugar is the generic name for sweet, soluble carbohydrates, many of which are used in food. Basically sugar is processed to remove impurities (dirt) and to make the product more consistent in quality and color. The processing plant we went to does that. Our group was small but lively.
